Public Budget Hearing Minutes October 18, 2022

CALL TO ORDER: A public hearing was held to discuss the proposed budget for 2023. Meeting was called to order by Chairman Ted Ryder at 6:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners: James Hartwick and Jay Phillips and Secretary Jillana Sinnott. Notice of public hearing was entered by the Fire Secretary.

PUBLIC HEARING: The Public Hearing was Opened.

No representative from the general public attended the hearing.

Motion made by Commissioner Hartwick, seconded by Commissioner Phillips to close the public hearing. Motion carried unanimously. Hearing was closed at 6:40 pm.

The Board considered whether it should, pursuant to Section 3-c of General Municipal Law, passed a resolution to override the tax cap limit for the 2023 budget year if needed.

Motion made by Commissioner Hartwick, seconded by Commissioner Phillips to override the tax cap in the form of the attached resolution. Motion carried unanimously.

Thereafter, Motion made by Commissioner Phillips, seconded by Commissioner Hartwick to approve the Final Budget. Motion carried unanimously.

Copies of the Final Budget and the resolutions will be sent to the Town Clerks.

Motion to adjourn at 6:42 pm by Commissioner Phillips and seconded by Commissioner Hartwick. Motion carried unanimously.

RESOLUTION

A meeting of the Nyack Joint Fire District was convened on October 18, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.

The following resolution was duly
offered and seconded to wit:

**RESOLUTION OF THE NYACK JOINT FIRE DISTRICT BOARD
OVERRIDING THE TAX CAP LIMIT**

WHEREAS, the tax cap limits the total levy set by local government, not assessed value or tax rate, generally to an increase in property taxes of no more than by 2% or the rate of inflation, which is less, unless they officially override the tax levy limitation; and

WHEREAS, the Nyack Joint Fire District may, pursuant to the authority of Section 3-c subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law, adopt a budget that requires a tax levy that is greater than the tax levy limit for the coming fiscal year, if prior to the adoption of its proposed and or final budget, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Nyack Joint Fire District overrides such limit for such coming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Nyack Joint Fire District is expressly authorized to override the property tax cap for the coming fiscal year by a vote of sixty percent (60%) of the Board of Fire Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Nyack Joint Fire District has duly and carefully considered the public safety and fire protection needs of the residents and taxpayers of the Fire District for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, after such careful consideration, the recurring, regular and other operating costs and obligations of the Fire District require it to exceed the tax levy cap imposed on the Fire District pursuant to General Municipal Law 3-c in order to maintain the level of fire protection and emergency services to the residents and taxpayers of the Fire District which is in the best interests of such residents and taxpayers, as determined by the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Nyack Joint Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is Resolved as follows:

Section 1. The District hereby ratifies and affirms each and every "Whereas" paragraph above as though set forth in full herein.

Section 2. Pursuant to the authority of Section 3-c subdivision 5 of the General Municipal Law, prior to the adoption of its proposed and or final budget, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Nyack Joint Fire District does hereby override such limit for such coming fiscal year only in order to achieve the purposes of the Nyack Joint Fire District.

Section 3. Having resolving to override such limit for the coming fiscal year only, the Board of Fire Commissioners is hereby authorized to adopt a budget for the fiscal year commencing January 1, 2023, that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the amount otherwise prescribed in General Municipal Law § 3-c.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective immediately.

The question of the adoption of the foregoing Resolution was duly put to a vote on roll call, which resulted as follows:
