FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the applicant proposed to place two lighted signs on the Rivian Automotive Building. One of the signs would be north facing above the proposed interior automobile entrance / exit. The other sign would be west facing and overlook the parking lot on the west side of the building. The signs would both:
 - be white and contain the corporate logo in red, followed by the words "RIVIAN" in black capital letters; and
 - o be lit from dawn to 12:00 am.
- 2. The Board found that the modern look of the signs would fit the modern look of the proposed building.

The hearing was then opened to the Public.

There being no one to be heard from the public, the Public Hearing portion of the meeting was closed.
