 - ★ 5/27 Monday - Blauvelt Lions Club Memorial Day Ceremony at 12 pm in Lions Park, followed by light refreshments.

 - ★ 5/27 Monday Memorial Day Parade - CR & RO Blauvelt American Legion Nyack Post 310 - Continues a proud Village of Nyack tradition of honoring the men and women of our community who made the ultimate sacrifice preserving our freedoms. The parade kicks off at 11:00 am, staging at Artopee Way municipal parking lot in Nyack (55 Artopee Way). The route follows Main Street from Franklin Avenue down to Broadway where it continues along Broadway and turns left onto Depew Ave then turning right on Piermont Avenue and continuing until dismissed by our Post. The ceremony will follow at the upper level of Memorial Park. The lower level is off limits due to the Village reseeding project. Our Grand Marshal will be our own past Post Commander Frank Pappalardo, a proud Korean Era Army Veteran. Guest Speaker will be Col. John H. Leighton, USMC (Ret), a highly decorated Vietnam Era helicopter pilot and Past Commander of the RC Marine Corp League.
