Orangetown Day Camp 2024 Registration & Fee Information

<u>SWIM NOTICE</u>: Campers will visit the South Orangetown Middle School indoor pool daily. Swim schedules by age group will be emailed weekly. Please be sure to send your child to camp with a swim suit, a towel, and goggles.

This packet provides a general overview of Orangetown Day Camp program offerings and fees. For more information regarding camp policies, please see the Day Camp Policy Packet at Orangetown.com/recreation. Camp registration will open online on Wednesday, April 17th at 5:00 pm. Field Trip registration will open online on Wednesday, May 1st.

Camp Location - The Orangetown Summer Day Camp program will be held at the German Masonic Picnic Grounds on 89 Western Highway, Tappan, NY 10983.

Eligibility - For children to be eligible they must have completed kindergarten and be entering 1st – 8th grade. Space is limited! **Please note that this program is for Orangetown residents only; non-residents will not be accepted**.

<u>Vaccination Record Submission Requirement:</u> The New York State Department of Health requires vaccination records to be submitted for every child prior to their attending summer camp. <u>Vaccination Records, and other medical documents (if applicable), must be submitted no later than Friday, May 31st, 2024.</u> Acceptable submission methods include uploading during online registration or one of the following after you register, but no later than Friday, May 31st, 2024. You can upload vaccination records to your Community Pass account after registration, email a scanned copy to <u>recreation@orangetown.com</u>, send a fax to 845-359-6991, or come in person during Recreation Office hours. Scans must be legible. Photos and screenshots are not accepted. <u>Mail-ins are not accepted.</u>

Camp Dates and Times – Camp will run from Monday, July 1 to Friday, August 9. The camp will be conducted Monday through Friday, 8:45 AM – 4:15 PM (except for the 1st week as there will be no camp on July 4th & July 5th). Space is limited.

Busing –Bus transportation will be available from designated pickup points in the Pearl River, South Orangetown and South Nyack areas*. **Busing will be an option at an additional cost.** While registering, you will need to add both your desired busing session(s) and day camp session(s) to your cart. Please note your pickup location selection in your online registration form.

Activities/Field Trips/Events - Activities will include Arts & Crafts, Films, Science, Sports, Games, Swimming, and other various group activities, as well as performers visiting day camp. Field Trips and Special Events will be available for an additional cost. Trips have limited registration availability and are first come first serve. Trip details and pricing information is available on page 4 of this packet. **Additional info –** Campers must bring their own lunch. Each camper will be provided a beverage at lunch time. All campers will be issued one camp t-shirt and string back pack.

To Register – Online Registration will open Wednesday, April 17th at 5pm. Camp registration is available online only via Community Pass. No mail-in or walk-in registration will be available for

this program. Visit https://register.communitypass.net/OrangetownRec to set up an account prior to registration. Medical forms are now included via the online registration process. Vaccine records will be required and must be submitted on or before Friday, May 31, 2024. The 2024 Medication Administration Form, is available our website at Orangetown.com/recreation and will be available for download during online registration.

Sibling Discount - A sibling discount will be offered for each session. The full amount will be charged for the first child, each additional child in the same sessions, will receive a \$20.00 discount for day camp.
