5. AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION OF THE 2024 ROCKLAND COUNTY, NY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN UPDATE

WHEREAS, all jurisdictions within Rockland County have exposure to natural hazards that increase the risk to life, property, environment, and the County and local economy; and

WHEREAS; pro-active mitigation of known hazards before a disaster event can reduce or eliminate long-term risk to life and property; and

WHEREAS, The Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Public Law 106-390) established new requirements for pre and post disaster hazard mitigation programs; and

WHEREAS; a coalition of Rockland County municipalities with like planning objectives has been formed to pool resources and create consistent mitigation strategies within Rockland County; and

WHEREAS, the coalition has completed a planning process that engages the public, assesses the risk and vulnerability to the impacts of natural hazards, develops a mitigation strategy consistent with a set of uniform goals and objectives, and creates a plan for implementing, evaluating and revising this strategy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Orangetown:

- Adopts in its entirety, the 2024 Rockland County Hazard Mitigation Plan Update (the "Plan") as the jurisdiction's Natural Hazard Mitigation Plan and resolves to execute the actions identified in the Plan that pertain to this jurisdiction.
- Will use the adopted and approved portions of the Plan to guide pre- and post-disaster mitigation of the hazards identified.
- Will coordinate the strategies identified in the Plan with other planning programs and mechanisms under its jurisdictional authority.
- Will continue its support of the Planning Partnership as described within the Plan.
- Will help to promote and support the mitigation successes of all participants in this Plan.

- Will incorporate mitigation planning as an integral component of government and partner operations.
- Will provide an update of the Plan in conjunction with the County no less than every five years.

6. AUTHORIZE / CHRISTMAS LIGHTING COMPANY / HOLIDAY LIGHTS / DOWNTOWN PEARL RIVER

RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes up to \$15,000 to Christmas Lighting Company to supply holiday lights for display in Downtown Pearl River, to be paid from the Pearl River Parking District budget line item SP 3320.457, and further authorizes the Supervisor or her designee to execute any and all documents for the installation of the holiday lights.

RESOLVED, the Town Board hereby approves the retention of Beckmann Appraisals, Inc., to conduct a fair market value appraisal of certain Town owned lands located at 175 Hunt Road, Pearl River, NY, identified as Tax Map 73.15/1/17, at a cost of \$4,500.00, pursuant to a written proposal dated October 15, 2024, incorporated herein by reference.

8. APPROVE PERMIT AGREEMENT / BUSINESSES TO DISPENSE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON TOWN PROPERTY / PEARL RIVER DAY / SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2024

WHEREAS, the Pearl River Chamber of Commerce has formally requested on behalf of the member businesses it represents, permission, pursuant to Town Code Section 10-4(B)(1) to dispense alcoholic beverages on Town Property as part of their Pearl River Day Festival held on Saturday, October 19, 2024, and

BE IT RESOLVED, that subject to the requirements of the New York State Liquor Authority regulations (SLA), including a securing a proper license therefrom, and the requirements of the Town of Orangetown Police Department, and to the execution of an agreement with the Town to provide indemnification and proof of insurance to the Town, and execution of an Agreement/Permit with respect to same, the Town Board hereby grants permission to the businesses authorized under the Pearl River Chamber of Commerce's permit to dispense alcoholic beverages upon Town property during the hours of 1 pm to 5 pm at the Pearl River Day Festival held on Saturday, October 19, 2024, nunc pro tunc.
