3. SET PUBLIC HEARING / APRIL 8, 2025 AT 7:05 PM / PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 39, "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC" WITHIN THE HAMLETS OF SOUTH NYACK AND TAPPAN

RESOLVED that the Town Board will hold a public hearing on April 8, 2025 at 7:05 p.m., on a proposed Local Law amending Chapter 39 of the Town Code entitled "Vehicles and Traffic" related specifically to the time limitation on parking and prohibition on parking on Gesner Avenue in the Hamlet of South Nyack and the prohibition on parking on Brandt Avenue in the Hamlet of Tappan.

4. AUTHORIZE RENEWAL AGREEMENT / GRANT WRITING SERVICES / MILLENNIUM STRATEGIES/ 2025

WHEREAS, the Town is aware of grant opportunities which would assist the Town in obtaining funding from Federal and State programs in various disciplines (e.g. recreation, planning, infrastructure programs and the like) which would be in the best interests of the Town to provide for funding of projects the Town has or intends to undertake, and

WHEREAS, the Town has received a renewal proposal from Millennium Strategies, Nanuet, New York, to provide grants consulting and project support services to assist the Town in completing projects in an efficient, cost-effective and timely manner, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Board hereby authorizes the retention of Millennium Strategies for purposes of providing professional grant writing services commencing March 11, 2025 through March 10, 2026 at the flat annual cost of \$5,000 split into two payments six months apart for grant consultation and \$150 per hour for grant writing services, and that the Supervisor or her designee is authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the purposes of this Resolution, upon review and approval of the Town Attorney's Office.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Parks, Recreation & Building Maintenance award the bid for tree removal at Blue Hill and Broadacres Golf Course to, O'Sullivan Tree Care of West Nyack, NY in the amount of \$227,600.00, the lowest qualified bidder, to be charged to account E.7250.200 (Blue Hill) and ER.7251.200 (Broadacres).

AWARD CONTRACT / ELECTRIC EQUIPMENT CATEGORY 1-MOWERS / ECO-QUIP LLC

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Parks Recreation and Building Maintenance award the bid for Electric Equipment Category 1, Zero Turn Mowers to Eco-Quip LLC of West Nyack, the lowest qualified bidder, for the purchase of two Mean Green Rival Mowers at a cost of: \$25,087.50 each for a total of: \$50,175.00 to be paid from grant funds.

8. AWARD CONTRACT / ELECTRIC EQUIPMENT CATEGORY 2-UTILITY VEHICLES / STORR TRACTOR CO.

RESOLVED, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Parks Recreation and Building Maintenance award the bid for Electric Equipment Category 2, Utility Vehicle to Storr tractor Co. of Branchburg, NJ, the lowest qualified bidder, for the purchase of two Toro Workman MDX Lithium at a cost of \$23,056.66 each for a total cost of: \$46,113.32 to be paid from grant funds.
