- 1. The Board found that the applicant had a previous approval (ACABOR #21-01) and requested an amendment to the plans. The changes requested a shortening of the canopy, and a simplified version of stone and wood paneling and brick. The texture of the back is slightly different. The applicant noted that there would be no changes to the lighting.
- 2. The Board found that the façade amendment should include some changes to the front façade and simplify the use of materials.

1. The Board found that the revised plans presented a simplified use of materials on the front elevation. The applicant modified the elevations to break up the façade at the two large areas of all white brick with additional bands of black brick. The new proposed look for the long side of the building did not accomplish a lightening with glass panels mounted on top of the building. Lidl's preferred to use more black which only weighed down the long side making it look even heavier. Therefore, after with a discussion with the architect and lawyer, the decision was made to return to the first design presented and to void the new suggestion given on March 6th.

FINDING OF FACTS:

- 1. The Board found that the applicant proposed a building façade with Steel Siding in grey, manufactured by Alucobond, or equal. Split face Stonework will be placed on the façade as noted on the submitted plans in Westbricks Metropolis, or equal. The color scheme of the building would be grays and blacks.
- The Board found that the building would be a small commercial operation, with site parking. Lighting on the site would be down lights on overhead doors and one pole mounted light in the parking lot.
- 3. The Board found that the applicant needed to make a separate application to ACABOR for the signs.
- 4. The Board found that the Air Conditioning Units would be screened by 4'6" boxwoods or evergreen plantings. The plants must be similar or the same height as the machinery.
