Location: Orangetown Summer Day Camp is held at the German Masonic Picnic Grounds on 89 Western Highway, Tappan, NY 10983.

Registration & Eligibility

Eligibility - Orangetown residents only. Children entering 1st - 8th grade.

Camp registration is available online only via Community Pass. No mail-in or walk-in registrations.

<u>Camp Registration</u>: Begins on Monday, April 21 at 5:00 pm and ends Friday, May 16 at 12:00 pm. <u>Field Trip Registration</u>: Begins Wednesday, April 30 at 10:00 am and ends Friday, May 31 at 12:00 pm.

Space is limited! Camp weeks often fill within the first night of online registration. Once registration fills, you may add your child(ren) to the wait list(s). No registrations will be taken outside of the registration window above. All registrations are on a first come, first serve basis.

What Do I Need Before Signing Up?

- □ Set up/confirm that you know your Community Pass username/password in advance. Visit <u>register.communitypass.net/OrangetownRec</u>
- Add/verify your child(ren)'s information on your account.
 Use your child(ren)'s current grade(s) for the 2024-2025 school year. During registration, the system automatically updates the grade they will enter in September.
- □ Your child(ren)'s t-shirt size (ex: youth small, youth medium, youth large, adult small, etc)
- □ Physician Name & Phone Number
- □ Emergency Contact/Authorized Pickup Info [at least 1 required] Additional adult(s) other than parents/guardians who may pick your child(ren) up from camp and/or be contacted in case of emergency if we are unable to reach you.

What Do I Need After Signing Up?

- □ Up to date Vaccination Record(s) for your child(ren) for the 2025 2026 school year. Must include vaccinations required for the grade your child is going into in September.
- Medication Administration Form (If Applicable) -This form must be filled out by a Health Care Provider and signed by a parent/guardian. It is required for any camper that will bring any medication(s) of any kind to camp.
 - □ A photo of your child must be submitted with this form to allow for quick identification purposes if your child requires transport to a local health care facility.
 - □ Medication listed must be brought to camp in order for your child to attend.
- □ IEP (if applicable)

Vaccine records and other medical documents (if applicable) <u>must be submitted on or before Friday,</u> <u>May 16, 2025</u>. Scans must be legible. Photos and screenshots are not accepted. 

Skyhawks Sport Camp Descriptions

BEGINNING GOLF

Skyhawks Golf focuses on building the confidence of young athletes by teaching proper technique to refine essential skills of the game. Golf is a challenging and lifelong sport, so young athletes need proper focus on the fundamentals of form, swinging, putting, and body positioning. To assist in this training, Skyhawks has adopted the SNAG (Starting New At Golf) system to its curriculum. Deveoloped by PGA professionals, SNAG utilizes a set of equipment designed for beginning golfers and simplifies instruction so that young players can make an easy and effective transition onto the golf course. **All equipment is provided**.

MINI-HAWK (BASEBALL, BASKETBALL, & SOCCER)

This multi-sport program was developed to give children a positive first step into athletics. The essentials of baseball, basketball and soccer are taught in a safe, structured environment with lots of encouragement and a big focus on fun. Our Mini-Hawk games and activities were designed to allow campers to explore balance, movement, hand/eye coordination, and skill development at their own pace.

SPORTS & GAMES

Our multi-sport camp is designed to introduce young athletes to a variety of different sports in one setting. For this program we combine soccer, baseball/softball, basketball, flag football, capture the flag and ultimate frisbee into one fun-filled week (each week will include 2 sports). Athletes will learn the rules and essentials of each sport through skillbased games and scrimmages. By the end of the week, your child will walk away with knowledge of multiple sports along with vital life lessons such as respect, teamwork, and self-discipline.

TRACK & FIELD

Using special equipment and age appropriate exercises and drills, Skyhawks staff will teach the standard track & field events: long distance, springs, soft hurdles, relays, shot put, javelin, and more. This program will prepare athletes for a future in cross-country and track & field events while inspiring a love for running and being active. The fundamentals of body positioning, stride, proper streching, and cool-down techniques are also covered.

VOLLEYBALL

Skyhawks Volleyball takes the energy and excitement of this great team sport and puts it all together into one fun-filled camp. All aspects of the game are taught through drills and exercises that focus on passing, setting, hitting and serving. This co-ed program is designed for the beginner to intermediate player and will incorporate essential life-lessons such as teamwork and sportsmanship. Coaches will assist each athlete in developing the fundamental skills of the game through game-based drills and daily scrimmages aimed at developing the whole player.





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
