FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the sign would be placed above the entry doorway, measuring 12' by 2'-4.8". The sign would be PVC, single sided, framed with wood, digital print laminated mounted to PVC. The sign would screw to the building front using lag bolts. The colors would be black, grey and white, as noted on the submitted plan.
- 2. The Board found that the sign would be lit during business hours.
- 3. The Board found that Gooseneck lights would be placed above the sign, as noted on the submitted plan. The light fixtures would be black and white LED lights.
