- **E.** A copy of the Building Permit Referral dated January 25, 2017, re-denied on March 15, 2018, signed by Building Inspector Mike Manzare.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The Board found that the application appeared at the Town of Orangetown Zoning Board of Appeals on Wednesday, May 16, 2018 for the review of the Performance Standards application.
- 2. The Board reviewed the submitted information regarding the generator enclosure and site location and found it acceptable.
- 3. The Board found that the applicant proposed to screen the generator with Emerald Green Arborvitae. The Board recommended that the type of tree be changed to Green Giant Arborvitae.
